


# Initial Positive Data from 134cm VLF Aerial with direct input into USB Soundcard at LRO 25/2/2026.

Some positive results from 25/2/2026:



## Lionel Loudet's SID Monitoring Station Data for 25/2/2026:




## Lichfield Radio Observatory (LRO) Data from 25/2/2026:

Surprisingly, the large SID between 6am and 7am is not obvious on my data below. The SID just before 10am is obvious, but the one at about 11:30am is less so. The one at 4pm is very obvious. SO, M-class flares seem to be clearly demonstrated, C-class ones are more variable. How has your setup fared today?
